## Update on COVID-19

You will be aware that case rates of Covid 19 are increasing again across the country and this pattern is consistent locally in Surrey. We are continuing to monitor our Risk Assessment and take appropriate actions. As part of this, we would remind you all to please be vigilant and continue to strictly follow all of the safety measures to keep our community safe.

Please do not send your child to school if they are unwell or are showing any of the COVID 19 symptoms. We would also ask that you notify the school so that we are able to manage our internal tracing.

If your child shows any of the Covid 19 symptoms, please do not send them to school and please do notify us so we can manage our internal contact tracing.

May we also remind you not give any medication such as Calpol before school as this means, if your child should become unwell at school, we are unable to make accurate temperature checks. We will be continuing with regular hand washing and hand sanitising as well as the taking of twice weekly lateral flow tests for staff.

We currently have no children or staff with COVID-19 or self-isolating. This is extremely good news and we are very hopeful that this will continue.
